- ◆ **Shawn Marshall MD, MSc, FRCPC** - Dr. Marshall is a specialist in Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Professor in the Department of Medicine, University of Ottawa, as well as an Associate Scientist at the Ottawa Health Research Institute. He is active in research involving driving and disability, and is co-principle investigator for CanDRIVE II - The CIHR Team on Older Person Driving. His primary research interests include the development of a decision rule in identifying medical fitness to drive, as well as research into the effectiveness of conditional licensing.
